## About us

We are a registered charitable organisation run solely by a team of volunteers based in London. WE provide disadvantaged and orphaned children around the world the opportunity for respite and healing in Istria, Croatia.



The stunning Istrian Peninsula is the setting for the annual summer project where children and youth from various social-economic, psychological and emotional backgrounds work with volunteering professionals and trained young people to build lasting and meaningful memories that can see them through the atrocities that they live amongst.

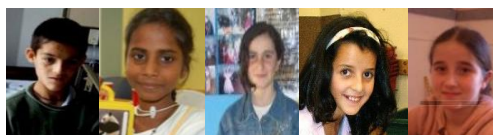


**The increasingly globalized world we live in provides for new and richer experiences. We hope to encapsulate that for the participants in the project. Istria at the Adriatic Sea is a place of natural wonder and demands to be explored. From the quaint old towns to the turquoise seas and craggy mountains; Istria does really lend itself to curious children and adventurous young people.**

## Our Approach

The annual summer project which started as an international youth project in 2006 in London will be a therapeutic program this year designed to help the emotional and spiritual well-being of orphans and youth. It enables the healing of their hearts through caring relationships while staying in the natural beauty of summer retreat location with its two SUMMER ORPHAN HOUSES and campsites in Sumer, Istria – a feast for the eyes of the soul and a light to the hearts.

The orphans (7-10 years old) are from war zones, areas of natural disasters or are otherwise emotionally deprived. We are facilitating the internal moment the hearts re-open. There are many added benefits of having a group of children and youth in a summer project; it primarily nourishes the healing relationships by raising their confidence and self-esteem. The children can then attempt to create changes in their own lives and that of their communities when they return. Children from previous projects of WLI (USA) :



## Our Ethos

### Vision

Our vision is to provide healing and support for orphans and also youth.

### Mission

We provide a summer holiday retreat programme with various therapeutic approaches (such as e.g. exposure to nature, art, music and drama therapy workshops)

### Core Values

#### *Inner development through service to orphans*

The core values underpinning the project are the reason for WLT's existence. All practises align with this principle. The volunteers are also developing their inner qualities through the service to the orphans; whether it is greater awareness, learning about oneself, overcoming challenges or gaining skills.

#### *Nobody working for World Life Trust gets paid.*

Everyone participating is a volunteer and also has to pay the costs for his/her trip to the orphan project location in Istria.

### Funds

The funds collected are solely spent on the orphans themselves (e.g. visa costs, airfares, food and accommodation).
